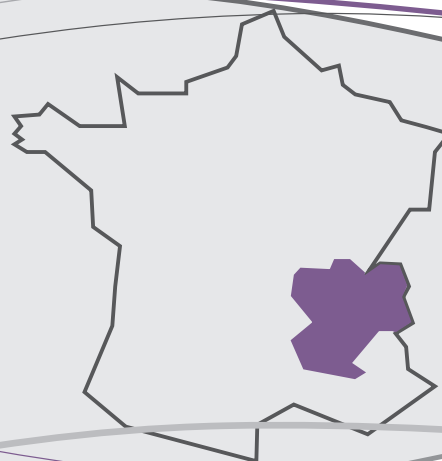


# International Open-Day

## Welcome to our «Instituts Universitaires de Technologie» (IUT) in Auvergne Rhône-Alpes Region!

The French Institutes of Technology are fully part of the university system. They select their students after their high-school diploma and have strong links with local business. There is a limited number of places available, making it a sought-after programme.

**This international forum is jointly organised by the Lyon, Saint-Etienne, Roanne, Chambéry, Annecy and Grenoble IUTs in order to:**

- Develop and strengthen the network of partners
- Increase international opportunities for students
- Promote the IUT system and joint actions between the IUTs
- Promote Rhône-Alpes, a prosperous and dynamic European region



The 115 IUTs are **part of a national network of IUTs and all follow a common National Curriculum leading to a DUT, equivalent to a Higher National Diploma in Technology, after two years of studies (see chart below).**

Since their creation, over 1 million students have been awarded a diploma and over 3,000 others a vocational Bachelor's degree by our institutions.

**After their diploma, students can:**

- Continue their studies in France or abroad at Bachelor's level and then at Master's level
- Start working

For their 3rd year abroad, they are awarded a DUETI, University Diploma in Technology in an International context.

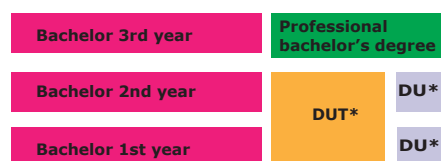

# Lyon 1

## Presentation of the Lyon 1 IUT

- 📍 The IUT de la Doua was founded in 1967 and merged with IUT B in 2009
- 📍 Number of students at the IUT: 5,000
- 📍 Part of: Université Claude Bernard Lyon 1
- 📍 Number of students at the University: 35,000
- 📍 Number of foreign partnerships: 80 Erasmus agreements + 35 framework agreements
- 📍 English-language programmes: 1 GEA MMIC (Marketing and Management in an International Context) + 1 semester 4 in IT
- 📍 Number of international students: Around 80 (for internships, the semester, or the year)

Thanks to close links with companies (around 800 partners) and the region's professional milieu, the IUT has developed 11 DUT degrees and 42 Professional Bachelor's degrees across three sites: Bourg-en-Bresse, Villeurbanne DOUA, and Villeurbanne Gratte-Ciel.

## Presentation of the Lyon 2 IUT

- 📍 The IUT was founded in 1992
- 📍 Number of students at the IUT: over 700
- 📍 Part of: University Lumière Lyon 2
- 📍 Number of students at the University: 30,000
- 📍 Number of foreign partnerships: 6 Erasmus agreements, 1 Framework partnerships and 2 Erasmus + programmes for IUT only as well as over 30 agreements in conjunction with University Lumière Lyon 2
- 📍 English-language programmes: in progress in STID and GLT
- 📍 Degree: 5 DUT and 7 Professional Bachelor's Degrees, all of them are tailored to suit our partner companies with a compulsory and progressive work-study programme. First-year students carry out a two-month internship and 80 % follow on with a year-long placement in the same company during their second year.

- 📍 Number of students at the University: 17,000
- 📍 Number of foreign partners: 40
- 📍 English-language programmes: in progress
- 📍 Number of international students: 23%
- 📍 The Roanne IUT has 5 DUT degrees, 5 Professional Bachelor's degrees, and has become increasingly open to the world through the development of a study abroad programme.

**The Roanne IUT organizes the event every other year, alternating with Saint-Etienne. Please note: there will not be a Forum in Roanne in 2017.**

## Presentation of the city of Roanne

### Demographics

- 📍 The Roanne conurbation has 101,405 inhabitants

### Higher Education

- 📍 2,000 students, 20% of which are international students
- 📍 Schools in Roanne: ITECH Roanne, IUT, Polytech...

### Economic fabric

📍 The region has a strong industrial history, mainly in the textile/clothing and engineering/armament industries. Even though these two industries were restructured in the 1970s, they remain major employers. More recently, the agro-food industry has shown strong growth. The long under-represented tertiary sector has also grown recently thanks to the creation and installation of call centres and IT companies (NumeriParc).

### Quality of life

- 📍 Roanne was founded on the banks of the Loire River in the Gallo-Roman era, and vestiges of that history still remain.
- 📍 Roanne also boasts a number of cultural activities.
- 📍 Roanne residents enjoy walking around the port area, a relaxing setting.
- 📍 Gastronomy: the famous Maison Troisgros, which has had 3 Michelin stars for more than 45 years!
- 📍 Places for nature lovers: forest, lake, canal...

### Quality of life

- 📍 Annecy is one of the most popular towns in the Alps, and is an attractive setting with woods, mountains and the Lake d'Annecy close to hand.
- 📍 Annecy is home to a number of important places and monuments and has also been classified as a Town of Art and History in France. The River Thiou is one of the shortest rivers in Europe. It is just 3.5km long most of which is in the canals running through Annecy making it such a beautiful city - the 'Venice of the Alps'.

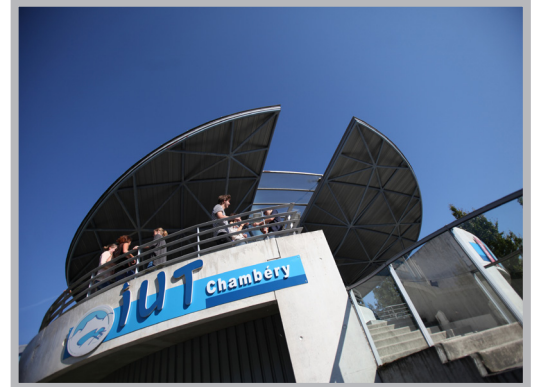

- 📍 University of Savoie also houses the Institute of Business Administration (IAE) and the Polytech Annecy-Chambéry Engineering School

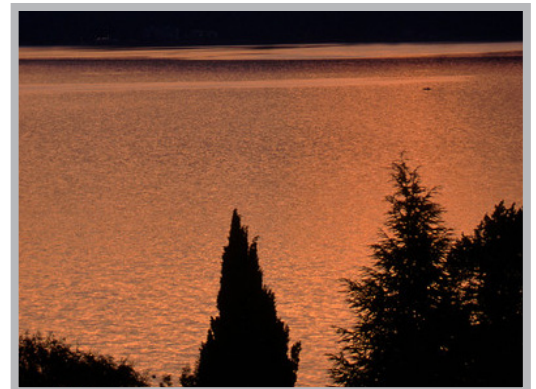
### Economic fabric

- 📍 An innovative spirit that fosters the emergence of new industries: renewable energy, industrial ecology and water recovery, and cutting-edge industries (optics, imaging, etc.)
- 📍 R&D activities (many laboratories)

📍 Crossroads of the Alps, the Chambéry conurbation has an exceptional environment and heritage: the Bauges and Chartreuse natural parks, Lake Bourget, Chambéry's historical town centre, world's biggest ski resorts, wide range of cultural and sporting activities.

📍 Grenoble boasts cutting-edge infrastructure such as MINATEC (micro-nanotechnology); Clnatec and Biopolis (biotech-medtech); and PREDIS (smartgid and fuel cells).

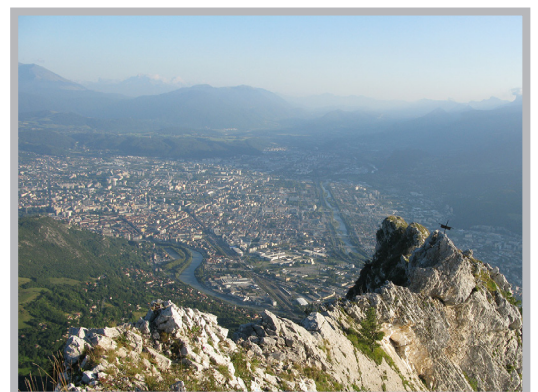
📍 Grenoble also has five major international research facilities: the ESRF (European Synchrotron Radiation Facility), the ILL (Institut Laue-Langevin), the EMBL (European Molecular Biology Laboratory), GHMLF (High Magnetic Field Laboratory), and the IRAM (The Millimetre Radio-Astronomy Institute).
